

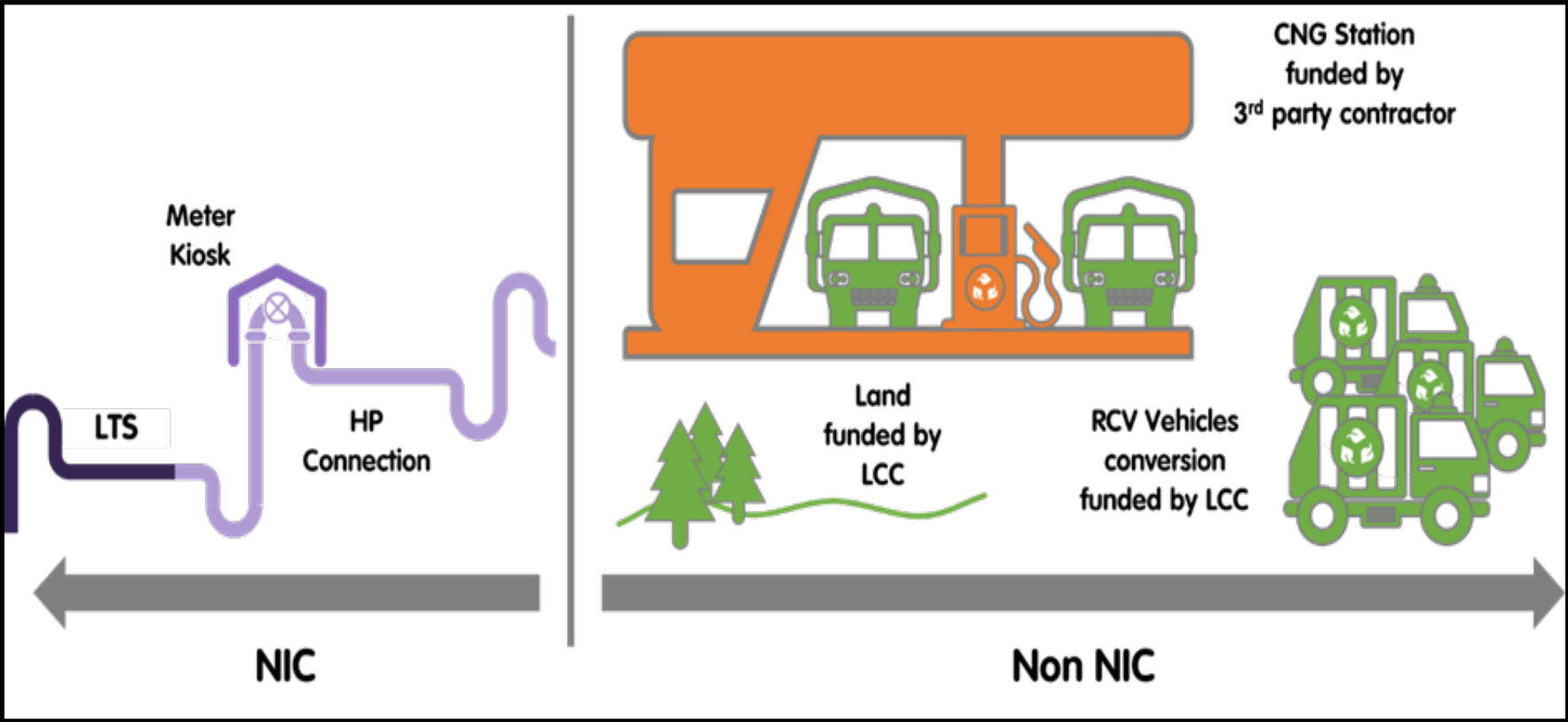

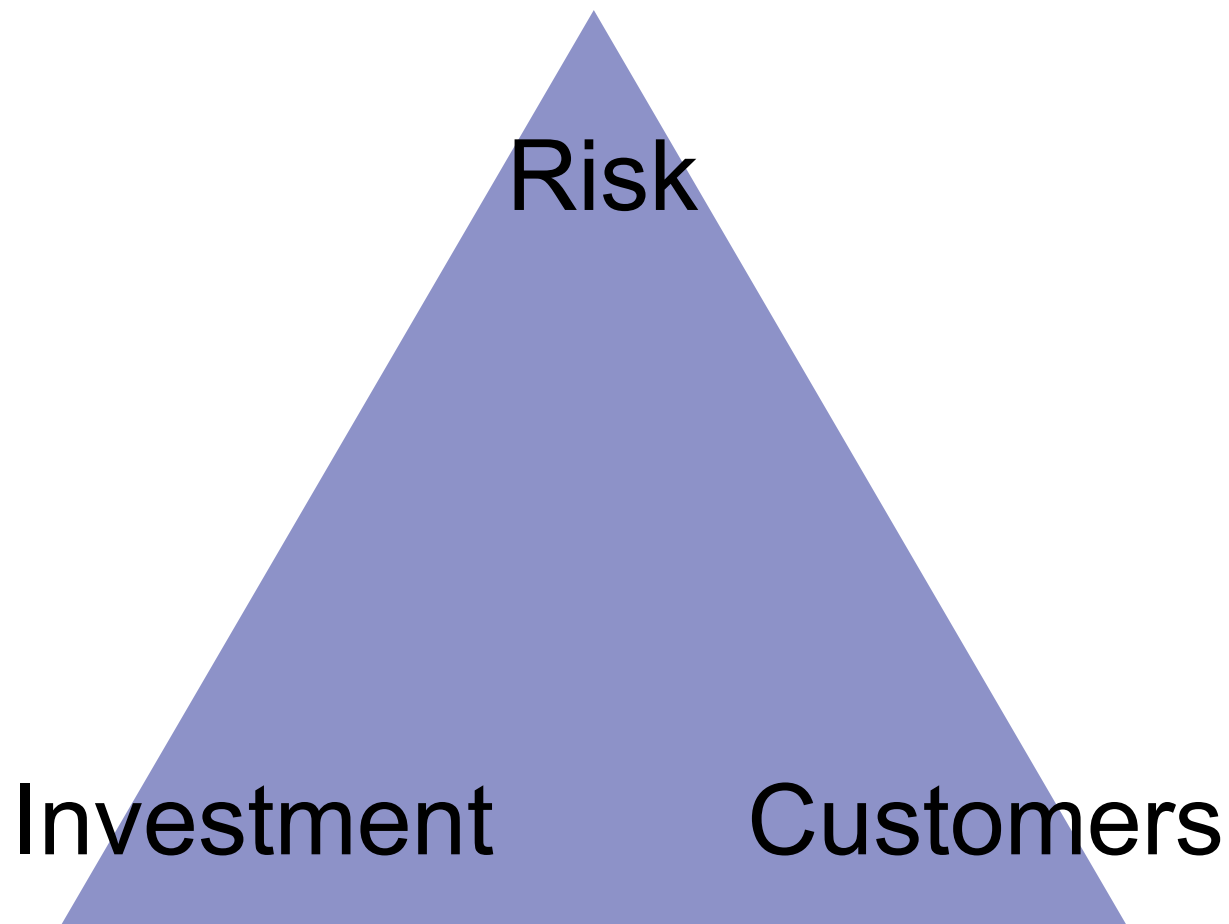

- Network Innovation Competition



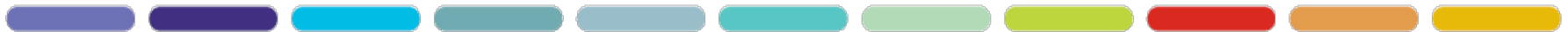
# Novel Commercial Arrangement

---

## Ye Olde Commercial Agreement

1. Bespoke Contract between LCC and NGN
2. Facilitates Connection Up Front
3. Enabled by Payment Mechanism linked to throughput

1. Removes Risk
2. Attracts Investment
3. By proxy leads to customers



# The Plan

---

- Go out to tender – appoint an operator (the third key party)
- Construction in 2018
- Conversion programme of RCV's
- Getting local businesses to convert



# National Infrastructure

- There is a real opportunity for all UK cities to have CNG stations built
- London linked with Leeds via Milton Keynes
- 350 mile range going up to 500 mile range
- Potential for similar stations within NGN
- More customers, more stations built, efficiencies increased from learning points
